

## TIOS - 40 HOURS OF COMMUNITY SERVICE

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The purpose of community service activities is to contribute to students' development. It will provide opportunities for students to learn about the contribution they can make to the community.

Student activities are not to displace workers or to take place during scheduled classroom time.

<u>Approved activities</u>: Students may seek community opportunities by offering assistance to service clubs, community groups, charities, conservation groups, health agencies and others. For example:

- Fundraising (not-for-profit organization)
- Community sports coaching
- Helping to organize community events
- Participating in environmental projects
- Assisting seniors

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- Participating in committees
- Participating in a community project

<u>Ineligible activities</u>: The following activities are ineligible for the accumulation of 40 hours of community service. For example:

- Any paid activities
- Co-operative Education experiences
- Any activity required for a school course
- Playing on a school or community team
- Court-ordered community service programs

- Alternative measures programs
- Any diversion programs
- Any activity unsafe or unsupervised
- Activities that are family responsibilities
